BENEFITS OF CLUB MEMBERSHIP

Club Ice - A good place to get to know other Club members is at Club ice, a key benefit for our Junior and Senior Club members at no additional cost! Join us at the Sugar Land Ice and Sports Center from 6:50-7:50 PM on Rink A on most Fridays. (During summer months rink B is used). Most sessions are open skating format but some sessions will be used for exhibitions, games and parties. This is at the club's discretion. Bridging Members are invited to the first club ice of the each month to skate as a benefit to their membership and to acquaint them with other club members.

Social Events – including annual Halloween party and December's annual gift exchange holiday party. College send off party, end of school and back to school socials. Competitor send-off parties and exhibitions for Southwestern Regionals, Midwestern Sectionals, Junior Nationals, US Nationals, and Adult Nationals competitions. Other events as funds allow.

Test Sessions – We generally offer 6 test sessions throughout the year. Our popular test sessions afford skaters the opportunity to test when ready so goals are achieved in a timely and uninterrupted manner.

Skater Development – Guest Skating Coaches, IJS Spins Scoring, Moves in the Field, Jump and Spin, Dress for Success, Doc Ali with Athlete Warrior program, and Developing a Winning Attitude are examples of seminars that have been offered in the past. U.S. Figure Skating Parents Code of Conduct for Texas Gulf Coast FSC

Codes of Conduct give everyone a guide to what is expected of us if we are part of an organization, participating in a sport, or as spectators at our child's events.

Preamble: The essential elements of character-building and ethics in sports are embodied in the concept of sportsmanship and six core principles: respect, responsibility, fairness, caring, trustworthiness and good citizenship. The highest potential of sports is achieved when competition reflects these "six pillars of character" (Arizona Sports Summit Accord)

By signing below I hereby agree that:

1. I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all skaters, coaches and officials at every practice session, competition and test session.
2. I will place the emotional and physical well being of my child ahead of my personal desire to win.
3. I will encourage my child to skate in a safe and healthy environment.
4. I will inform my child's coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.
5. I will teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning, so that my child will never feel defeated by the results of a competitive event.
6. I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other participant for making a mistake or blame my child's teammates for placement in a competition.
7. I will do my best to make skating fun and will remember that my child participates in sports for his/her own enjoyment and satisfaction not mine.
8. I will ask my child to treat other skaters, coaches, fans, and officials with respect, regardless of race, creed, color, sexual orientation or ability.
9. I will applaud a good effort in both victory and defeat emphasizing the positive accomplishments and learning from the mistakes.
10. I will teach my child to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
11. I will be a positive role model for my child and other skaters.
12. I will demand a figure skating environment for my child that is free of drug or alcohol abuse and agree that I will not use or provide to a third party any drug proscribed by applicable federal, state, or municipal law.
13. I will not assist or condone any competing athlete's use of a drug banned by the International Olympic Committee, International Skating Union, United States Olympic Committee, or U.S. Figure Skating, or, in case of athletes, to use such drugs or refuse to submit to properly conducted drug tests administered by one of these organizations.
14. I will not provide alcohol to, or condone the use of alcohol by minors, abuse alcohol in the presence of athlete members, or at U.S. Figure Skating activities or, in the case of athletes, consume alcoholic beverages while a minor.
15. I will encourage my child's coach to continue their education and training through programs offered by U.S. Figure Skating, the Professional Skaters Association and other accredited organizations.
16. I will respect my child's coach and refrain from coaching my child or other skaters during competitions and practices because it may conflict with the coach's plan or strategies.
17. I will respect the decisions of officials and their authority during competitions and test sessions and teach my child to do likewise.
18. I will show appreciation and recognize the importance of volunteers and club officials.
19. I will study the rules of the U.S. Figure Skating and teach my child accordingly so that we have an understanding and appreciation of the rules of competition and membership.
20. I will support all the opponents in my child's competition and respect the rights of all skaters to participate.

I hereby release, discharge, and covenant not to sue the Texas Gulf Coast FSC, United States Figure Skating, it’s directors, officers, administrators, sponsors, volunteers, agents, employees, staff, instructors, trainers, other participants and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises on which the “activity” takes place (each considered one of the “Releasees” herein) from all liability, claims, demands, losses, or damages on my account caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the “releasees” or otherwise, including negligent rescue operations; and I further agree that if, despite this release, waiver of liability, and assumption of risk, I, or anyone on my behalf, makes a claim against any of the Releasees, I will indemnify, save, and hold harmless each of the releasees from any loss, liability, damage, or cost which any may incur as the result of such claim.

The Texas Gulf Coast FSC has the right, but not the obligation, to provide rules, regulations and/or ice monitors for Club Ice. We hereby acknowledge that the Texas Gulf Coast FSC shall not be responsible for the supervision of the members at Club Ice.

I have read this RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT, understand that I have given up substantial rights by signing it and have signed it freely and without any inducement or assurance of any nature and intend it to be a complete and unconditional release of all liability to the greatest extent allowed by law and agree that if any portion of this agreement is held to be invalid, the balance, notwithstanding, shall continue in full force and effect.

Texas Gulf Coast Figure Skating Club Guidelines for Skater Stipends

approved 10/12/03, amended 5-31-08

The Texas Gulf Coast Figure Skating Club (TGCFC) is “organized for non-profit and educational purposes to encourage all persons to participate in the sport of figure skating (and) to assist and support, financially or otherwise, Home Club Members in the training for, traveling to, and participation in U.S. Figure Skating (USFS) Regional, Sectional, and National Championships, including Junior National Championships and other competitions sanctioned in accordance with USFSA rules.”

Stipend funds allocated for each membership year are evaluated and voted on by the TGCFC board in October. The funds available are based on the Club funds which are raised for stipends through fundraising and other events.

Stipend payments are made in August for the previous year’s eligible events. To qualify for stipend payments, skaters must be full members for the entire previous membership year, and be in good standing for the current year for which they are applying for a stipend payment. In other words, two full years of membership are required in order to be eligible to receive a TGCFC stipend.

TGCFC does not normally award stipend payments for Regional Championship participants. If, after awarding stipends for Sectional and National participation, funds which are designated for stipends remain, the board may elect to open stipend application to Regional participants. Stipend funds and eligibility for Regional participants will be determined by board vote in October.

The amounts listed below are the maximum stipend allowances per event and are based on funds available. The board may determine that it is necessary to award lesser amounts. Only events requiring travel out of the Houston area are included for consideration for stipends.

Sectional Championships	Singles - \$250 ; Pairs/Dance - \$50 per skater (funds permitting)
Junior National Championships	Singles/Pairs/Dance- \$500 per skater
US Figure Skating Championships	Singles/Pairs/Dance \$1,000 per skater
Adult Sectionals (Non-qualifying events)	Singles/Pairs/Dance - (funds permitting) - \$25 per skater
Adult Sectionals (Qualifying events)	Singles/Pairs/Dance - \$100 per skater
Adult Nationals (Qualifying events)	Singles/Pairs/Dance - \$100 per skater
Regional Championships (Non-qualifying events)	Singles Events (Pre-Juvenile, Open Pre-Juvenile, Open Juvenile) - \$25
Regional Championships (Qualifying events)	Singles Events (Juvenile, Intermediate, Novice, Junior, Senior) - \$50
Membership Stipend	Full Home Club members who complete 25 or more hours of volunteer service to TGCFC may apply for a \$25 credit of club membership fees

The amounts shown above will be paid based on 1) the club’s ability to remain financially solvent, 2) avoid negatively impacting other sustaining programs and 3) the skater’s successful completion of the following.

1. Skaters must pay junior or senior level fees and declare themselves Home Club skaters of Texas Gulf Coast Figure Skating Club.
2. Renewal Membership fee must be received by the Club Treasurer on or before July 1 for the new membership year after the participated in competitive events.
3. Skaters must be Full Home Club members of Texas Gulf Coast Figure Skating Club for one full year before becoming eligible for a stipend.
4. Skaters must apply for stipends no later than June 1. Applications may be submitted any time after the requirements are met.
5. Skaters must volunteer for the benefit of the club to include:

TGCFSC Guidelines for Skater Stipends contd.

25 hours of documented volunteer time during the CURRENT membership year (July 1st - June 30th). Hours worked by the skater's family can be applied to the skater's total hours. Families with more than one skater applying for a stipend must collectively work 40 documented hours.

- Autumn Fest, Skate Houston and any TGCFSC Sponsored Ice show
- Test sessions
- Club ice
- Other opportunities as they occur

Volunteer hours may be awarded for donations of food commensurate with its value and preparation time. Volunteer hours may be awarded for fund raising activities commensurate with their value. Individuals serving on the Board of Directors, Skate Houston Chairs, and others as determined by the Board may be exempt from this policy.

Skaters are encouraged to wear the official TGCFSC Club jacket or other TGCFSC Club clothing at the competitions.

In addition to the above, the board will take into consideration the following when determining a skater's eligibility to receive a stipend payment:

1. Participation in approved mentoring activities for the benefit of Club members. Examples include elite skaters attending Club ice to mentor skaters, presenting at a Club seminar, or writing articles for the Club newsletter when asked.
2. Participation in periodic special stipend fundraisers including skating in TGCFSC sponsored shows, if any.
3. Agreement to allow TGCFSC to use their name, photos and any other likeness to promote the Club.

TEXAS GULF COAST FIGURE SKATING CLUB GENERAL ICE RULES

Ice rules are necessary for the safety of all skaters, to programs running smoothly, and to insure that each participant receives equal consideration.

General Rules

- Safe skating is essential. Club members are expected to be considerate of other skaters at all times.
- No hockey sticks, pucks, or food allowed on figure skating ice.
- No standing around during freestyle sessions. Standing is allowed only next to the back wall hockey boxes or in lesson with your instructor.
- Texas Gulf Coast Figure Skating Club members are guests of Sugar Land Ice & Sports Center. Skaters are expected to follow all Sugar Land Ice rules and regulations as well as take direction from rink personnel when appropriate.

Check-In for Freestyle Sessions and Classes

- Every skater must check in with the ice/class monitor before taking the ice or beginning the class. Appropriate cards must be punched PRIOR to taking the ice.

Freestyle Sessions Skating

- Program music is played by rotation in the order it is requested of the ice monitor. Skaters requesting music who are in lesson with a coach take priority over skaters in practice on their own.
- Skaters practicing their program with music have the right-of-way. It is the responsibility of the skaters to be aware of who is on the ice, who is skating his or her program, and knowing who should yield the right-of-way.
- Training Freestyle sessions are for athletes working in their sport, not for socializing. If you are not practicing and training as directed by your coach, please leave the ice and participate in public session skating.
- All ice rink rules with respect to property and proper behavior are expected to be followed at all times on the ice.
- Promptly leave the ice at the end of your sessions. If the doors to the Zamboni bay open, exit the ice immediately.
- Pay attention to the areas of training on the ice. Respect the right-of-way of others.

Report any/all injuries and accidents to the ice monitor on duty IMMEDIATELY.

I have received and will abide by all ice rules. Failure to do so could result in ejection from the ice.

TEXAS GULF COAST FSC CLUB ICE RULES

These rules were approved by the Board of Directors 2-16-2008.

1. All skaters participating in club ice agree to abide by the rules for behavior and safe conduct posted by Sugar Land Ice and Sports Center. Any skater found not adhering to these rules or performing any act considered unsafe or destructive may, at the discretion of the TGCFC Ice Monitor or member of Sugar Land Ice and Sports Center rink management, be asked to leave the facility and may have club ice privileges suspended or revoked.
2. **All skaters must check in** with the ice monitor prior to taking the ice. Guests must be registered and a **fee of \$10.00** paid to the ice monitor prior to taking the ice, see rule 7.
3. The club Ice Monitors/TGCFC DJ are in charge of club ice and all questions or problems should be directed to one of them.
4. **No more than 30 skaters** are permitted on the ice at one time under any circumstance. It is the discretion of the Ice Monitors/DJ to split the session into 2 – 30 minute sessions to accommodate all skaters if necessary. Rule shall be that the last ones on are the first ones off if the ice is over 30 and they will be the first on in the next session if two are needed.
5. **ONLY TGCFC HOME CLUB FULL MEMBERS are allowed on every club ice session.** Anyone who is not a full member is required to pay the \$10.00 guest fee. (Exception – see rule 6)
6. **Bridging TGCFC Home Club members** are permitted to skate the first club ice session of each month.
7. **Guests:** must be rated ISI/USFSA Freestyle 1 or above and must be with a current full home club member. Guests must introduce themselves to the ice monitor who will collect the **\$10.00 fee** and sign them in with their name, parents' name, and parents' phone number *prior to taking the ice*. Guests may not be admitted to the ice if there are over 22 members already on the ice. TGCFC members always have priority admittance to club ice over guests.
8. **MUSIC:** Club ice is for the skaters to skate and be social. Music may be requested via the Texas Gulf Coast web site to the DJ. There are to be no coaching, lessons, or program music played on club ice without prior Board request and approval. The Board reserves the right to use club ice for exhibitions/critiques/etc. as needed through out the year.
