### TEXAS GULF COAST FIGURE SKATING CLUB (TGCFC) TEST RULES

The privilege to test with TGCFC is expressly conditional upon full compliance with all of the application requirements and rules contained herein and to those in the TGCFC Constitution and Bylaws, the TGCFC Official Rules and Policies, and USFSA Rules and Regulations.

- 1 ***The test application must be filled out completely and correctly.*** A complete application includes the applicant's name, USFSA number, street address, city, state, zip code, test date requested, age (if under 18), telephone number (including area code), USFSA home club, and, if not a TGCFC home club member, if the applicant is a TGCFC second club member. Mark all appropriate boxes for tests to be taken. Additionally, for dance tests, list any junior and/or senior dance tests to be taken. Circle the type of dance test (i.e. standard, adult, or masters) to be taken, if this will complete a dance level, and if the applicant will need to solo. Include the dance partner's name, USFSA number, and if the dance partner has passed the pre gold dance test or higher. In the test application fees box, add up all fees, including test fees, a \$7.00 food fee (used to purchase food for the judges), and, if applicable, a \$20.00 **per test** fee if you are not a TGCFC club member or are not testing as a partner of a TGCFC club member and a \$25.00 late fee if your letter is postmarked (metered postmark not accepted) after the test application deadline. The test application must be signed by the applicant (or parent/guardian if under 18) and the professional. The name of the applicant (or parent/guardian if under 18) and professional must also be printed.
- 2 Test applications must be mailed to the Vice President – Testing of the Texas Gulf Coast FSC or delivered to the “Club Book” in the Pro Shop of Sugar Land Ice & Sports Center.
- 3 Due to the TGCFC policy of subsidizing tests for club members, if an applicant is not a TGCFC club member, there is a \$20.00 per test non-TGCFC club member fee.
- 4 If an applicant is not a TGCFC home club member or is a USFSA individual member, a letter of permission to test must be provided by a duly authorized representative of the applicant's home club prior to taking any test.
- 5 Any applicant in arrears for membership dues or other financial obligations to the TGCFC shall not be allowed to test until all indebtedness is paid in full.
- 6 The test applicant (or parent/guardian if under the age of 18) is responsible for any bank charges resulting from returned checks and must pay any such charges within three day's notice.
- 7 Beginner members must convert to either a junior or senior membership prior to taking any USFSA tests.
- 8 Test applications filed by TGCFC home club members before the application deadline have placement priority over applications filed by all other applicants, and test applications filed by TGCFC second club members before the application deadline have placement priority over non-members. However, all applications filed prior to the application deadline have placement priority over late applications. Late applications are accepted on a first come, first serve basis but are placed only if time allows, the late fee is paid, and the required judges are available.
- 9 Test application fees are refundable only if the test session is not held. If the TGCFC cancels a test or test session for any reason, the test applicant will have five days after notice of the cancellation of the test or test session to exercise an option (in writing to the test chairman) either to receive a refund or receive a carryover credit for the same test(s) at the next regularly scheduled test session. The carryover application will have placement priority over any application subsequently filed, whether by a TGCFC member or a non-member. Failure to exercise the option will be deemed to be an election to receive a refund. If the option to receive a carryover credit is exercised, failure of a “carryover” applicant to appear at the next scheduled test session will result in the forfeiture of the test application fees.
- 10 If a test applicant fails to show up to take the test(s) after submitting a test application form, the test applicant may be eligible to receive a credit to take the same test(s) at a future test session if the test applicant can demonstrate that failure to take the test(s) is because of a medical condition that a physician certifies will prevent the test applicant from testing safely or because of a death in the test applicant's immediate family. Requests for a test credit must be made in writing to the TGCFC Board within four weeks after failing to take the test(s). The credit request should list the reason the test applicant is applying for a credit and include all relevant documentation. At the sole discretion of the TGCFC Board and by majority vote of the Board, the credit request will either be approved or denied. At the discretion of the Test Chair, carryovers may be granted for non-medical reasons. Should the carryover be granted it is subject to a \$20 reschedule fee.
- 11 The test schedule will be e-mailed to all Houston area rinks five days prior to the test date.

The TGCFC, Board members of the TGCFC, and Test Committee members of the TGCFC make no warranties, either expressed or implied, as to TGCFC's ability to provide the test applied for in this application. All tests are scheduled only as ice time allows and judges are reasonably available. Additionally, all tests are scheduled at the exclusive and sole discretion of the TGCFC Vice President – Testing or Test Chair, taking into consideration the costs of acquiring judges for the test session and other factors. Further, per USFSA rules and TGCFC rules, the applicant and parent/guardian agree to hold harmless the USFSA, the TGCFC, Board members of the TGCFC, Test Committee members of the TGCFC, and the ice facility at which these tests are being conducted from any and all loss, damage, and/or injury that may be sustained by anyone in any manner while participating in TGCFC test sessions.
